Forearm Sculpture and flap course

This one-day course compliments and can precede the Hand and Wrist construction course. It involves a layered assembly of the volar and dorsal soft tissues, using coloured modelling wax and 3D printed nerve and vascular elements, on a 3D printed skeletal armature.


The morning will include three lectures as set out below.

The afternoon session will involve tutored construction of a radial forearm, posterior interosseous, and Becker flap using the constructed forearm model. The models will be judged by an objective panel, and a prize awarded accordingly.
